TASTING NOTES

The beautiful shining salmon robe displays orange reflections. The first nose is very "gourmand" and opens with notes of apricot underligned by delicate spicy notes of safran and nutmeg. On the palate, the attack is fresh and revolves around notes of orange sorbet. It continues with delicate and fine notes of crystallised violet and rose. The tannic structure completes this very elegant wine.

FROM VINE TO WINE

Share of the vineyard dedicated to rosé: 2.25Ha Grape varietal: 100% Braquet Average age of the vines: 25 years Average yield 25 hl/Ha Morning harvest to maintain crispness Temperature-controlled maceration, malolactic fermentation Ageing: 6 months in stainless steel tanks

THE TERROIR

The unique soil, called "Poudingue", is made of pebbles rolled from Pliocene era and a clear compact sand with clay veins. Planted on the hills of Nice, the vineyard overlooks the Mediterranean Sea. In the background, we can admire the Alps and the Var Valley. Located between 200 and 300 meters above sea level and benefits from great sunshine all year round (2,700 hours per year).

The breath of sea and alpine winds, offers a slow maturation process, necessary for the freshness and elegance of the wines of Bellet.

THE VINEYARD

The vineyard is cultivated using organic farming methods. Situated at the peakof the AOP Bellet, the vineyard benefits from a south, south-west sun exposure.

The Barons of Bellet family gave their name to this winery and to the appellation while their motto, "res non verba", remains at the heart of everything we do. And so, for over 400 years, « actions over words » has made the greatness and uniqueness of Chateau de Bellet wines.
